

Legacy Letters WORKSHOP PROPOSAL

Would those in your community be interested in an opportunity to share their life lessons and wisdom with others in their life? Might they want a chance to establish a tangible legacy that can be preserved for future generations? If so, perhaps a Legacy Letter Workshop at your organization would be a complement your existing programming.

A legacy letter (also called an ethical will) is a personal statement that reveals values, insights and even stories about your life to preserve your life lessons. Writing skills are not required, only the desire to reflect on your important life experiences and communicate things you hope others might gain from them. Many who write a legacy letter receive enhanced personal clarity through the process of reflecting. There is no right age to write a legacy letter, and it's never too early to start.

A legacy letter is not a legal document. It is often created along with a legal will or other estate planning documents, but a legacy letter can be written yourself and revised anytime you wish.

My Legacy Letter Workshop is a free, one-hour workshop which includes a PowerPoint presentation explaining what a legacy letter is and providing an overview of the six elements which make up the typical letter. I also share a sample letter and allow time for Q&A.
